

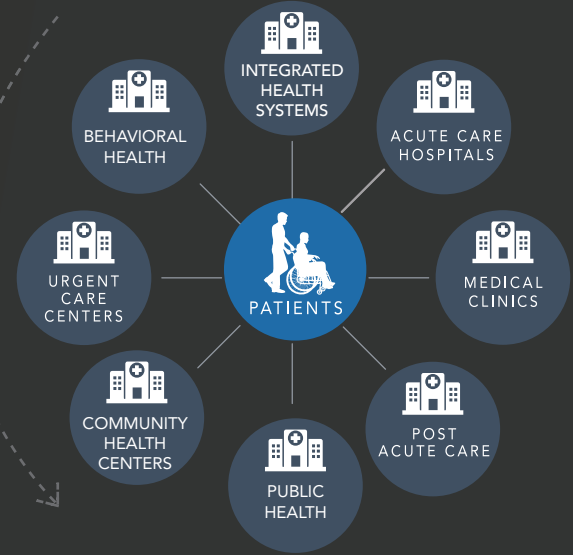
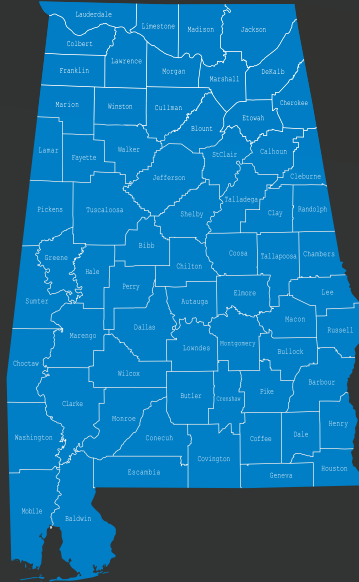

CALL TO ACTION

The ShareSafe Response Network (SRN) is uniquely positioned to help Alabama respond to and manage the COVID-19 health crisis. The Alabama SRN was the first state-wide network to combine communication, virtual collaboration, knowledge dissemination and data exchange. The platform unites state and public health officials, hospitals (academic, community, public, private, rural or critical access), CEOs, clinical teams and post-acute care personnel on one secure mobile platform. The SRN is powered by Vortex, ShareSafe's hyper-secure mobile platform, connecting the State's healthcare systems to improve the lives of its citizens.
